### EXHIBITOR JUNIOR CHAMPION/Reserve

Limit: Two(2) Models per exhibitor per class., except performance classes are limited to three (3) models per exhibitor per class.

Divisions: No age divisions. Classes are open to all ages unless specified. For Juniors 14 & under, the age of exhibitor is figured as of January 1, 2024..

Lunch Break: Lunch break will be announced. Bring a bag lunch or purchase a 4" Subway with salsa & chips and lemonade for \$5

Tags: Models must have a string tag tied to the horse's pastern in order to show, so your models can be identified. On one side of the tag please print your model's name, breed and gender: on the other side, please print your full name or unique ID.

Stabling: Tables may be pre- assigned. You may be sharing a table. Please organize your show string accordingly and cooperate with your table partner.

Awards: Flats 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup>. Rosette ribbons for Champion and Reserve. Championships will be determined by showback

Showback for Championships: In divisions offering championships keep track of all your 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners. They will be called back for championship judging. Showbacks will be done after that section is complete.

Junior Championships: Junior exhibitors keep track of ALL your 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners. They will be called back for championship judging at the end of the show.

Entry Fees: Entries postmarked on or before May 18, 2024

\$20.00 per stable, shows all day

Entries received after deadline or on the day of the show

\$30.00 per stable, shows all day
